

Practice Requirement

Gaining an appreciation of music through the study of piano is a rewarding experience that, if pursued wholeheartedly, will enrich a person's entire life. Playing the piano is a skill, which requires self-discipline and dedication. Progress in developing this skill is a direct result of time spent at the piano. To insure maximum results, Mrs. Henri requires the following practice commitment, at least 5 sessions a week outside of lesson time:

Primer Level – 20 minutes
Elementary Levels – 30 minutes

Intermediate Levels– 45 minutes
Advanced – 60 minutes

Any student making slow progress due to lack of practice will be placed on a one-month probation period. At that time, I will contact the parents to discuss new practice habits and routines that will hopefully correct the situation. If efforts to improve are not seen by the end of this period, I will notify the parent of dismissal. Please sign and return the following Practice Agreement by the beginning of September.
